Target Group

Youth workers were selected from six different organisations (including some external local organisations in order to spread entrepreneurship learning over Lithuania). Innovation Office selected the most motivated youth workers.

Train the trainer 1

First trainings using non-formal methods were held on April 1st, 2016. Lithuanian partner Innovation Office organised Pilot Trainings to 5 youth workers within the topic of Youth Entrepreneurship Skills Development.



Train the trainer 2

Second round of trainings for youth workers were held on August 30th, 2016 as Lithuanian partner Innovation Office organised Pilot Trainings to 4 youth workers within the topic of Youth Entrepreneurship Skills Development in Work with Youth.
